


Freshers' welcome service—sun 8 oct 6.15pm

Dr Kaye McLelland - 29 Oct (wk4)

Kaye is a Lay Leader of Worship at St Paul's Bedford. She is a lecturer in Renaissance Literature, having completed a doctorate on violence and liminality in the works of Spenser and Shakespeare, followed by a postdoctoral fellowship on early modern preaching and the body.

The Rev'd Liam Cartwright - 12th Nov (wk6)

Liam is a curate in Cowley, Oxford Diocese. Prior to ordination he was a professional organist, choral conductor, and teacher, having studied at the Royal College of Music. He is a founder member of Sacred and a Trustee of On Fire Mission, which promotes Charismatic Catholic worship in the Church of England.





The Rev'd Prof. Steven Shakespeare - 19 Nov (wk7)

Steven is an Anglican priest and Professor of Continental Philosophy of Religion at Liverpool Hope University. He has written a number of books of academic research, liturgy and poetry, including The Earth Cries Glory (2019) and Come Holy Gift (2022).

Adele became a Christian as a teenager and has been a member of Holy Trinity Elim Church in Weston-super-Mare ever since. She is passionate about working with young people and supporting their self-esteem and wellbeing. She has worked with several charities in the UK and overseas.
