

# GUEST PREACHERS THIS TERM




### The Rev'd Dr Ben Vertannes—12 May (wk 4)

Ben has been a curate in Streatham, South London for the last two years. His background is in the study of medieval history, secondary school teaching and a spot of football refereeing. A particular focus of his parish work is ministry with children and young people.

## The Rev'd Canon Prof. Mark Chapman—19th May (wk 5)

Mark David Chapman is Vice-Principal and Academic Dean of Ripon College Cuddesdon, Professor of the History of Modern Theology at the University of Oxford and Canon Theologian of Truro. He has written on many different aspects of Anglicanism, Church history and theology.
