## The Rev'd Molly Boot—4th May (wk 2)

Molly is a theologian, musician and priest, currently based in rural Gloucestershire. They're very enthusiastic about music, prayer, LGBTQ+ liberation, and medieval church history. They are a trustee of the Greenbelt Festival and the British Trust for Tantur, a charity supporting study at an ecumenical institute between Jerusalem and Bethlehem.

# DrTim Middleton—25th May (wk 5)

Dr Tim Middleton is a Tutorial Fellow in Theology at Regent's Park College, University of Oxford. His research focuses on the intersections of theology and religion with science, nature, and the environment.





### Br John Church OP — The University Sermon 15th June (wk 8)

Br John Church OP is a deacon in his final year of studies at Blackfriars Oxford, preparing for priestly ordination. He first encountered the Dominicans while studying Classics at Queen's and entered the noviciate in 2018. An attraction to religious life initially grew out of time spent working with the Missionaries of Charity, which then crystallised into a Dominican vocation through a desire to integrate the contemplative life with preaching and study.
