STUDENTS WHO HAVE EXAMS

Please apply for vacation residence if you have exams in 9th and 10th week.

We would usually book the room for you ahead of the vacation residence process; however, due to a delay in receiving the final list of confirmed exams, this hasn't been possible this year. We kindly ask you to complete the vacation residence application form so that these bookings can be processed, thank you.

APPLICATION PROCESS INFORMATION

The application form will close at 12:00pm on Friday 29 May 2026.

It will not be possible to obtain permission after this deadline unless there are exceptional, unforeseen circumstances. You will be informed by the end of 6th week whether you have been granted vacation residence permission or not. Applications received after the deadline will not be accepted.

Each day of vacation residence booked will be charged to your batells at **£19.56 per night**.

You are reminded that there is not automatic right to stay in College and further information regarding Vacation Residence can be found in the [Regulations](#) and on the [College website](#). **Please read all information carefully before applying.**

Vacation residence is normally permitted only for undergraduate Junior Members in week 0 and week 9 of any term, with the exceptions outlined in paragraph 10.13 of the College Regulations. When applying, you will need to have a clear reason for staying according to the Regulations. You may be asked to provide evidence to support the reason.

YOUR DEPARTURE DAY

ALL ROOMS MUST BE COMPLETELY CLEARED OF BELONGINGS AND POSSESSIONS MUST NOT BE LEFT IN ANY COMMUNAL AREA OF COLLEGE DURING VACATIONS.

You will need to leave the bedding provided by College (duvet, pillow and mattress cover) in your term time room.

If you need to temporarily store your belongings on your departure date after 10am while you wait before leaving/moving to another room, you can use the following spaces:

- Main College: JCR
- Carrodus Quad: down to the gates (it is undercover)
- St Aldate's House: the kitchens



- Cardo: living room

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Bicycles and storage

Students who will be completing their course this summer and leaving Queen's or going on their year abroad MUST remove their bicycle from College property and they are not permitted to leave any belongings in storage.
